- Workforce




SHIP FY 15 Program Report

 - Care Transitions




Participating SHIP Hospitals FY09 - FY15





Use of SHIP Funds FY10 - FY15






Value-Based Purchasing FY13 – FY15








SHIP Hospital Use of ACO Funds FY 2013 - FY 2015







SHIP Hospital Use of Care Transition Funds FY 2014-2015


