Community Facilities Loan & Grant Program	Disaster Assistance
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • USDA provides loans and a limited amount of grant funding for the construction, renovation, or purchases and installation of equipment for essential community facilities for public use in rural areas. • Eligible projects include fire and police facilities, community centers, hospitals, schools, city vehicles, food banks, daycare centers, and more. • Eligible applicants include most state and local government entities, nonprofit organizations and federally recognized Tribes. • Projects must be located in rural areas and towns of up to 20,000 in population • Long-terms fixed-rate loans. The length of term depends on the type of facility being improved or equipment installed and its useful life. • Grant funding awarded based on financial need, availability of funds and are a maximum of \$50,000. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • USDA can help rural communities repair or rebuild their community facilities and replace damaged equipment after a disaster.
