- 2b. Provide technical assistance on issues that directly impact the health of rural residents such as pesticide exposure, physical health, oral health, mental and behavioral health, farm safety, and more

- 3a. Advocate for state and national policies that support the health of rural residents and strong rural healthcare systems
- 3b. Encourage grassroots advocacy through leadership development and education
