

In doing so, we **strengthen the great work** already happening in communities throughout the County, while allowing us to **identify gaps** in services and treatments so that we can **save lives together.** The goal is to focus on evidence-based practices outlined by the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMSHA) and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) to reduce exposure to opioids, prevent misuse, and treat opioid use disorder.




# Total Overdose Deaths, Lancaster County 2014-present (as of 3/1/2019)





# 2018 Overdose Deaths in Lancaster: A Closer Look




# PDMP Opioid Dispensing Rate



## PDMP Risky Prescribing Measures




